# Guidance Notes for Year 11 Students

## Examination Period 2019: 30 April – 14 June

Students who are attending any taught session, revision session, or examination, should always report to the Academy at 8.15 am as normal.

If you have any doubt where you have to go, please report to the restaurant.

If you are in school you are always expected to attend PT or assembly.

### Start of exams

If you have a morning examination, you must report to and stay in the restaurant by 8.15 am.

During this time, you will have breakfast, be registered and can complete last minute revision.

Exams will start promptly at 9 am, with movement to the exam venue commencing at 8.45 am.

If you have an afternoon examination, you must report to the restaurant at 12.00 for your lunch and can spend some time on the Hard Play. By 12.35pm, you should be reporting to your exam venue for a prompt 12.45pm start.

### After exams

At the end of an exam, you will either attend a teaching session or report to ILC.

A senior member of staff will be present outside of the exam venue (normally the amphitheatre) to ensure that you report to the right venue after an exam. Please move quickly and quietly without disturbing the learning of others around the Academy.

### Completion of exams

All students will complete exams on Friday 14<sup>th</sup> June (Physics). All students need to have completed Vocational courses before the end of Year 11, attendance at school until 19 July will be expected for any student that needs this time to complete such courses.

Students are expected to attend all sessions which have been arranged as they are designed to provide bespoke support right up to the final exam. **Students need to take personal responsibility for being in the right place at the right time!**

The Academy expects all students to continue meeting our high standards for uniform and behaviour. This applies at all times during the examination period.
