Please do not telephone for your results as we are unable to disclose them over the telephone. If you are unable to collect your results in person and would like them posted, please leave an **A4** stamped addressed envelope (large letter stamp required) at the Academy Gatehouse by Monday 14 August 2017.

**If you are not coming to collect your results, we still need to see you before the end of August to support you and confirm your destination.**

Once you have collected your results you need to confirm your destination with Miss Beddard in the Careers Base. Staff will be available to assist with any UCAS/Career planning issues. A Destinations Form will be enclosed with your results for you to complete.

## Re: Process Following AS Results

I write to inform you of the process that will take place on AS Level results day (Thursday 17 August).

Students will need to come into School to collect their results between 12.30pm and 3.00 pm on Thursday 17 August. Based on their results, they will need to pass through one of three channels:

<b>Green</b>	Pleasing results in all subjects. Students will be advised to continue with their four A Level Programme.
<b>Amber (Self select)</b>	If students wish to drop one A Level, they will need to meet with a member of staff in the Amber Channel. If they decide to do this at a later date they can meet with senior staff on Thursday 24 <sup>th</sup> August (2.30pm - 4.00pm).
<b>Amber</b>	A student achieves an E (or equivalent) or below in one subject. Students will be advised to drop their weakest subject.
<b>Red</b>	A student achieves an E (or equivalent) or below in two or more subjects. Students will need to meet with member of senior staff and/ or the careers staff to discuss potential alternative provision.

In any case, **ALL** students must discuss their situation with a member of staff on the day and it is therefore imperative that students are available or have representation on the day. If parents or students are unable to attend, please make us aware (email [vbeddard@sandwellacademy.com](mailto:vbeddard@sandwellacademy.com)) in advance. If no contact is made on the day without prior warning, we cannot guarantee subject availability for students.

Please note, if students decide to study a three A Level programme, extra time will be timetabled for their remaining subjects / independent learning in school and students will also need to take responsibility for organising formal volunteering or work experience opportunities. Students will therefore still be considered full time.

If students are following a vocational programme, e.g. Performing Arts or Sports, please note that we strongly recommend that students continue with their fourth academic A Level.
